

# Spot me a... Lesser flamingo

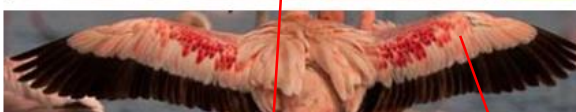
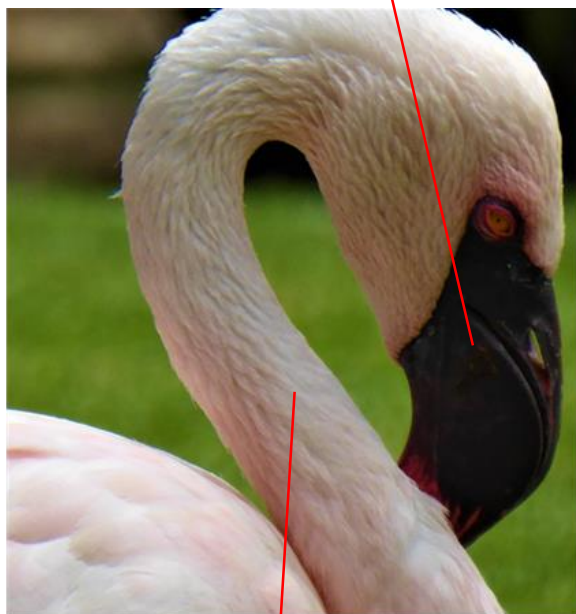
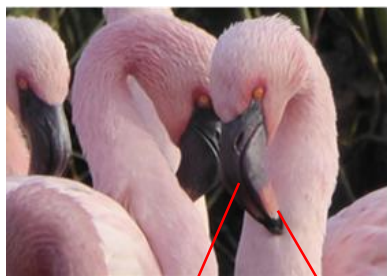
*Phoeniconaias minor*



More red/pink feathering compared to greater flamingo.

Very dark bill (red and large black area).

Bright orange eyes are most apparent when birds are in breeding condition.



Very thin upper mandible (deeply keeled bill).

Tiny size compared to greater flamingo.

Bright red legs and webbed feet.

Distinctive round red patch on bill.

The usual black primaries / secondaries and bright red coverts.
